Description of the Defect: Installation of the suspect rear step kit can change the load path through the

vehicle's frame during a rear impact event, and may cause the rear control arms to buckle, potentially resulting in unintended contact with the fuel tank.

Description of the Safety Risk: Unintended contact of the fuel tank by the rear control arms during a rear

impact event may damage the fuel tank, potentially resulting in a fuel leak, which in the presence of an ignition source, may lead to a vehicle fire,

- On June 4, 2019, the FCA US LLC ("FCA US") Vehicle Safety and Regulatory Compliance ("VSRC") organization opened an investigation as a result of testing and analysis of the bed step from Mopar Body Engineering.
- In July 2019, FCA US VSRC and Engineering met to review the issue, and understand the potential customer consequence, scope, and component and system test results.
- As of August 20, 2019, FCA US identified zero CAIRs, zero VOQs, and zero field reports related to this issue.
- As of August 20, 2019, total warranty is 0.0 c/1000.
- As of August 20, 2019, FCA US is not aware of any accidents or injuries potentially related to this issue.
- On August 22, 2019, FCA US determined, through the Vehicle Regulations Committee, to conduct a voluntary safety recall of the affected vehicles.

#### **Description of Remedy:**
